MAP and Dibels Testing and Reports

September 11-15 we will be doing Dibels screening on K-1. During the following week of September 18-22, your 1st-8th graders will take a test called Measures of Academic Progress® (MAP). We give students these tests three times per year to determine your child's instructional level and to measure academic growth throughout the school year and from year-to-year in the areas of Mathematics and Reading. Your student's data reports from the fall testing will be mailed in the weeks following testing. These reports will help us target areas where we can best help your child grow academically. Through partnering to help all kids learn, parents and teachers can have a profound positive effect on the lives of our students.
